Arrival On Site

The school office is located in the main entrance. On arrival you will be asked to sign in using the electronic system. A badge and a lanyard will be issued to you which should be worn.

Photographs

To comply with the Data Protection Act of 1998, we need to ask parents' permission to take photographs of children. Please consult the office if you will be taking photographs of any of our children.

Security

Please keep valuables with you at all times. If you leave the building for a short time, please inform the office.

Equality

We do not tolerate prejudiced based bullying incidents of any kind. All incidents should be recorded and dealt with by a senior member of staff.

Fire Safety & Evacuation Procedures

On hearing the fire alarm:

- Immediately evacuate the building via the nearest fire exit, ensuring that all doors are closed behind you.
- Do not put yourself in any danger.
- Do not panic or run.
- Proceed to the assembly point (playground or carpark).
- Do not return to the building until instructed to do so.

Disabled Visitors

If you have a disability and feel you may need assistance during an evacuation, please advise the office staff at the time of signing in and arrangements can be made to assist you.

Smoking

Please note that to maintain a healthy and safe environment, the school operates a 'no smoking' policy.

First Aid

In the event of an accident, please contact a member of staff. We have trained first aiders on site who will be able to assist.
